Feast of the Divine Mercy: This Sunday is now widely known to have been designated by St. John Paul II as Divine Mercy Sunday. This new feast has come about because of the revelation of Jesus to the late St. Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun to whom John Paul II had a great personal devotion. Just as the revelations given in the 17th century to St. Margaret Alacoque were to emphasise the love of God through the image of His Sacred Heart, the message given to St. Faustina concerned the mercy of God towards repentant sinners.
