In his Angelus address on the Italian *Day for Life* in February this year, Pope Francis said to thousands gathered in St Peter's Square, 'May no one be left alone and may love defend the sense of life'. Citing the words of Mother Teresa of Calcutta, he continued: 'Life is beauty, admire it. Life is life, fight for it... Each life is sacred.

Let's pray together for those children who are in danger of interruption of pregnancy and for those who are nearing the end of life.' These words can help us rediscover a spirit of awe towards the gift of human life and stir our hearts to the wonder of this gift. Pope Francis also points out that we have not done enough to support and accompany pregnant women in desperate circumstances.
