Across The United Kingdom, Remembrance Sunday is marked by ceremonies at local war memorials in most cities, towns and villages, attended by civic dignitaries, ex-servicemen and women. Wreaths of remembrance poppies are laid on the memorials and two minutes' silence is held at 11am. It is a day to remember all the servicemen who died in all the wars, and this year in particular, we celebrate the centenary of the end of the First World War.
