## OFSTED Inspection 2024

Dear Parents,

Christ the King was inspected by OFSTED on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> November and Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> November 2024. OFSTED are the inspection body responsible for evaluating UK schools. Inspectors made a graded judgement on the following 5 key areas:

- The Quality of Education
- Behaviour and Attitudes
- Personal Development
- Leadership and Management
- Early Years provision

The full report is attached but I am delighted to confirm that Christ the King has maintained its Outstanding grade and has been judged as **'Outstanding'** in all 5 areas.

This is a huge achievement that our entire school community should be proud of.
